Mr. Julien was born in Wilmington, North Carolina. He received a BS in Chemistry in 1995. Prior to working for the FBI, Mr. Julien was an SAP System Integrator employed by DSM Pharmaceuticals in Greenville, North Carolina.

Mr. Julien entered on duty as a Special Agent (SA) of the FBI on July 10, 2005. From 2005 through February 2009, SA Julien was assigned to the El Paso Division, where he worked Counterintelligence investigations and participated in the division's SWAT team.

In February 2009, SA Julien was transferred to the Atlanta Division, Brunswick Resident Agency where he worked Counterintelligence, Criminal, and Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) matters. As a field agent, SA Julien participated in the division's Hazardous Material Response Team.

In July 2012, SA Julien was promoted to Supervisory Special Agent (SSA) of the WMD Directorate, Nuclear and Radiological Countermeasures Unit. As SSA he engaged domestic and international personnel to strengthen Counterproliferation policy and provide international training to improve detection capabilities.

In August 2015, SA Julien was promoted to Unit Chief of the Counterintelligence Division, Foreign Investment Unit where he provided national security guidance to the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States on behalf of the FBI.

Assistant Legal Attaché Julien reported to Bucharest as the Assistant Legal Attaché on September 4, 2016. He is married and has a son.
