Mr. Talos was born in Timisoara, Romania. He received a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science with an International Relations concentration from University of California, Los Angeles in 1997. Prior to working for the FBI, Mr. Talos was a deputy sheriff with Orange County Sheriff Department in California. Mr. Talos entered on duty as a Special Agent (SA) of the FBI on August 7, 2005. From 2005 to 2013, SA Talos was assigned to the Los Angeles Division, where he worked Violent Crimes investigations in the Riverside Resident Agency and later worked Counterterrorism (CT) in the Orange County Resident Agency. Mr. Talos was a member of the division's Rapid Deployment Team and SWAT Team. In 2013, SA Talos was promoted to Supervisory Special Agent (SSA) at FBIHQ in the HUMINT Program Management Unit. In 2015, SSA Talos transferred to the International Operations Division, Global Training Unit where he was responsible for all training and capacity building in Europe and Eurasia, and later as operations Program Manager in the Eurasia Unit. Mr. Talos accepted and completed temporary duty assignments as Acting ALAT Bucharest, Romania, in 2008 and 2011, and Acting ALAT Ankara, Turkey, in 2016. He reported to Bucharest, Romania in March 2017 as the ALAT covering organized crime maters.
